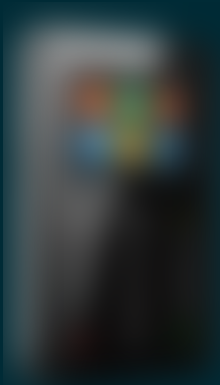

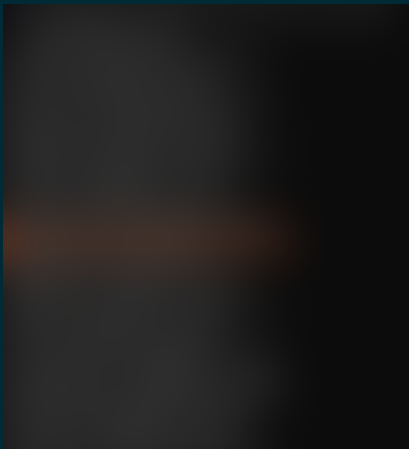

Root Root

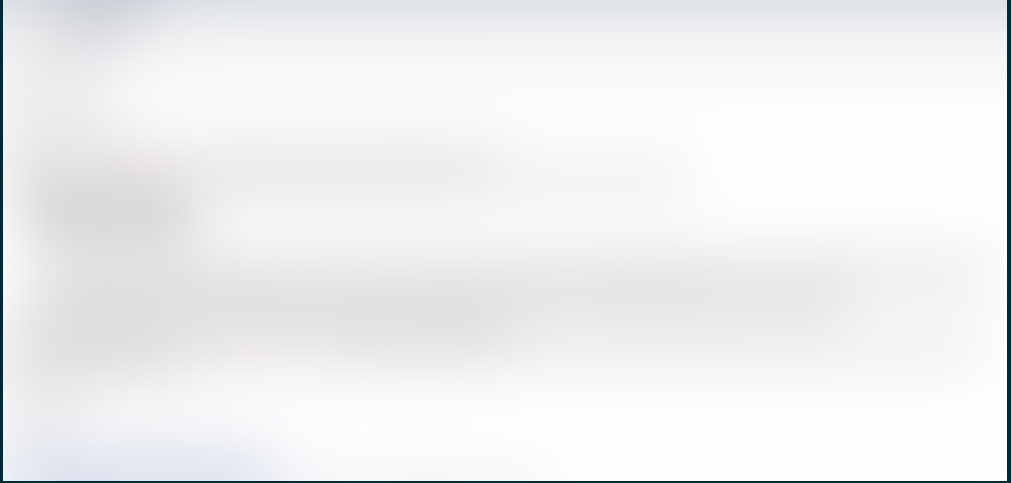


- Kernel is old, some privileged binaries have multiple stack overflows
